

Veristo User Agreement

Version October 19, 2018

When you use the services offered by Mile Out Inc. (“Mile Out” or “we”) through veristo.com, all websites associated with Veristo (including all domains and sub-domains of veristo.com), Veristo-branded communications, and other services (“Veristo” or the “Services”) that indicate that such services are offered under this User Agreement (this “Agreement”), you agree to and accept all of the terms of this Agreement and, further, that you agree to enter into a legally binding contract through this Agreement with Mile Out.

Veristo Approach

Veristo has been developed by Mile Out to provide tools to help support efficient sourcing, engaging, and managing the activities of your extended workforce of freelancers, consultants, contractors, and vendors by small businesses and sole proprietors. Veristo is not a rigid system that prescribes a certain way to work or a marketplace that charges you for every freelancer engagement. Instead, Veristo is a dynamic resource to help you attempt to remove transactional friction in engagement and management of freelance and contract activities ranging from requests, proposals, proposal selection, and contracts.

Participation

Eligibility – You promise that you are eligible to enter into this Agreement and you are at least our “Minimum Age.” To use the Services, you agree that: (1) you must be the “Minimum Age” (defined below) or older; (2) you will only have one Veristo account; and (3) you are not already restricted from using the Services. “Minimum Age” means (a) 18 years old for the People's Republic of China, (b) 16 years old for the Netherlands, (c) 14 years old for the United States, Canada, Germany, Spain, Australia and South Korea, and (d) 13 years old for all other countries. However, if law requires that you must be older in order for Veristo to lawfully provide the Services to you (including the collection, storage and use of your information) then the Minimum Age is such older age. The Services are not for use by anyone under the age of 13.

User Account – As a User, you promise that you will keep your password a secret. You will not share an account with anyone else and will follow our rules and the law. As between you and others, your account belongs to you. You agree to: (1) try to choose a strong and secure password; (2) keep your password secure and confidential; (3) not transfer any part of your account (e.g., your network, your content, etc.) and (4) follow the law and the terms of this Agreement. You are responsible for anything that happens through your account unless you close it or report misuse. Your account will allow you to maintain a single user profile with multiple actionable sub-profiles for work as an individual and/or as part of one or more organizations (an “Organization”).

Free Users and Paid Users – Veristo has both free Users and paid Users, which have different privileges of Veristo utilization as described in <https://veristo.com/our-story/pricing/> and as may be updated from time to time.

Notices and Service Messages – You consent to us using Veristo, including, but not limited to veristo.com, email and short message service (“SMS”) to provide you with important notices. Also, you agree certain additional information can be shared with us. If the contact information you provide isn't up to date, you may miss out on these notices. You agree that we may provide notices to you in the following ways: (1) a banner notice on the Services, (2) an email sent to an address you provided, or (3)

through other means including mobile number, telephone, or mail. You agree to keep your contact information up to date.

Messages and Sharing – Our Services allow messaging and sharing of information in many ways. Information and content that you post to your Veristo profile and Veristo organizational profiles may be seen by other Members, but Veristo request, proposal, proposal selection, contracting, and invoicing content is only visible to Users to whom you authorize access or to whom an Organization in which you participate has authorized access. We are not obligated to publish any information or content on our Service and can remove it in our sole discretion, with or without notice.

Utilization

Confidential Information – Your Veristo User profile information and our Veristo Organization profile information is considered public information, but all other Veristo information related to Veristo request, proposal, proposal selection, contracting, and invoicing is considered confidential information that is owned exclusively by you or your Organization and available for use only by other individuals from your Organization or to whom you have authorized access in Veristo to such Veristo request, proposal, proposal selection, contracting, and invoicing information.

Appropriate Utilization – Appropriate utilization of Veristo, by you, will mean that you will comply with all applicable laws, including, without limitation, privacy laws, intellectual property laws, anti-spam laws, export control laws, tax laws, and regulatory requirements. In addition, you will provide accurate information and keep it updated and use the Services in a professional manner. Veristo is intended to promote constructive extended workforce management activities, including request, proposal, proposal selection, contracting, and invoicing content, among other functions.

Inappropriate Utilization – Inappropriate utilization, which provides immediate grounds for termination of your use of Veristo means that you will not:

- Disclose information that you do not have the right to disclose (such as confidential information of others (including any Organization with which you are affiliated));
- Act dishonestly or unprofessionally, including by posting inappropriate, inaccurate, or objectionable content;
- Add any content that you do not own or have some other legal right to add;
- Add content that is not intended for, or inaccurate for, a designated field within Veristo;
- Misrepresent your current or previous positions and qualifications;
- Misrepresent your affiliations with a person or Organization, past or present;
- Misrepresent your identity;
- Misrepresent your capacity to sign requests, proposals, proposal selections, contracts, or other documents for yourself or your Organization;
- Create or modify a User profile for anyone other than yourself (a real person);
- Use or attempt to use another User's account;
- Create, use, or modify an Organization profile for any Organization (whether a business, a government agency, or another type of organization) for which you do not have appropriate authorization;
- Harass, abuse or harm another User or Organization;
- Send spam or other unwelcomed communications to others;
- Scrape or copy profiles and information of others through any means (including crawlers, browser plugins and add-ons, and any other technology or manual work);

- Act in an unlawful, libelous, abusive, obscene, discriminatory or otherwise objectionable manner;
- Violate intellectual property rights of others, including patents, trademarks, trade secrets, copyrights or other proprietary rights;
- Violate the intellectual property or other rights of Mile Out related to Veristo;
- Post any unsolicited messages or unauthorized advertising, “junk mail,” “spam,” “chain letters,” “pyramid schemes,” or any other form of unauthorized solicitation;
- Post anything that contains software viruses, worms, or any other harmful code;
- Manipulate identifiers in order to disguise the origin of any message or post transmitted through the Services;
- Create profiles or provide content that promotes escort services or prostitution;
- Creating or operate a pyramid scheme, fraud or other similar practice;
- Copy or use the information, content or data of others available on the Services (except as expressly authorized);
- Copy, modify or create derivative works of Veristo or any related technology;
- Reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble, decipher or otherwise attempt to derive the source code for the Services or any related technology, or any part thereof;
- Imply or state that you are affiliated with or endorsed by Mile Out or Veristo, without express consent;
- Rent, lease, loan, trade, sell/re-sell access to the Services or related any information or data;
- Remove any copyright, trademark or other proprietary rights notices contained in or on our Service;
- Remove, cover or obscure any advertisement included on the Services;
- Share or disclose information of others without their express consent;
- Use manual or automated software, devices, scripts robots, other means or processes to access, “scrape,” “crawl” or “spider” the Services or any related data or information;
- Use bots or other automated methods to access the Services, add or download contacts, send or redirect messages;
- Monitor the Services' availability, performance or functionality for any competitive purpose;
- Engage in “framing,” “mirroring,” or otherwise simulating the appearance or function of the Services;
- Access the Services except through the interfaces expressly provided for such activity;
- Override any security feature of the Services; and/or
- Interfere with the operation of, or place an unreasonable load on, the Services (e.g., spam, denial of service attack, viruses, gaming algorithms).

Management – Public information on Veristo is moderated. Unprofessional, false, misleading, profane or defamatory content are not appropriate for Veristo.

No Endorsement – Mile Out does not necessarily endorse, support, sanction, encourage, verify or agree with the content posted on Veristo. Any information or material placed online by Users do not necessarily represent the views of Mile Out. By submitting any content for posting, you agree that Mile Out is not responsible, and shall have no liability to you, with respect to any information or materials posted by others, including defamatory, offensive or illicit material, even material that violates this Agreement.

Service Availability – We may change or discontinue any of our Services. We can't promise to store or keep showing any information and content you've posted. We may change, suspend or end any Service,

or change and modify prices prospectively in our discretion. To the extent allowed under law, these changes may be effective upon notice provided to you. You agree that we have no obligation to store, maintain or provide you a copy of any content or information that you or others provide, except to the extent required by applicable law and as noted in our Privacy Policy.

Other Content, Sites and apps – When you see or use others' content and information posted on our Services, it is at your own risk. Third parties may offer their own products and services through Veristo, and we aren't responsible for those third-party activities. By using the Services, you may encounter content or information that might be inaccurate, incomplete, delayed, misleading, illegal, offensive or otherwise harmful. Veristo generally does not review all content provided by our Users. You agree that we are not responsible for third parties' (including other Users') content or information or for any damages as result of your use of or reliance on it. You are responsible for deciding if you want to access or use third party sites that link from our Services.

Limits – We have the right to limit how you connect and interact on our Services. We are providing you notice about our intellectual property rights. Mile Out reserves the right to limit your use of Veristo, including the number of your connections and your ability to contact other Users. Mile Out reserves the right to restrict, suspend, or terminate your account if we that you may be in breach of this Agreement or law or are misusing the Services (including violating this Agreement).

Non-Binding Activities

All requests, proposals, and contracts created, negotiated, transmitted, or otherwise manifested or produced on Veristo are deemed non-binding unless or until a contract is executed between two parties, consisting of one or more Users and or duly authorized Users representing entities. Unless otherwise explicitly stated, no liability or compensation shall be due to any User from use of Veristo.

Mile Out shall have the right to terminate your ability to access and use Veristo, including closing your Account, in accordance with the community guidelines, for any reason or no reason, at any time without notice.

At your request, Mile Out will close your Account by disabling all future use of such Account. However, you understand and agree that Mile Out may retain any information associated with your Account to the extent that Mile Out is required to retain such information as required by applicable law or to report such information to third parties, including law enforcement authorities or other federal, state, municipal, provincial, territorial or local taxing authority.

Proprietary Software and Intellectual Property Rights

Veristo is proprietary to Mile Out. Except with respect to content uploaded to Veristo by you ("User Content"), as between you and Mile Out, Mile Out has sole and complete ownership of Veristo, all content thereon and all intellectual property rights therein. As such, you will not (1) create or operate any platform, site or business that is based in whole or in part on the processes or content on Veristo, without the prior written consent of Mile Out; (2) copy, reproduce, modify, create derivative works, publish, distribute, transmit, publicly display, or post on any other website any content from Veristo without prior written consent from Mile Out; (3) reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble, modify, distribute, reproduce, republish, or sell in any form or by any means, in whole or in part, Veristo; or (4) injure Veristo in any way, including through the creation or deployment of any virus or corrupted data or copying the Veristo website or hindering the functioning of Veristo. Subject to your agreement with and continued compliance with this Agreement, Mile Out hereby grants you a limited, non-exclusive,

revocable, non-transferable license to use and access the portions of Veristo that you are authorized and eligible to use and access. This limited license is revocable by Mile Out at any time without notice and with or without cause. All rights not expressly granted by Mile Out are reserved.

You hereby grant Mile Out a non-exclusive, worldwide, transferable, fully-paid, royalty-free, perpetual, irrevocable right and license (with the right to sublicense), through all media now known or hereafter created, to use, access, view, listen to, copy, modify, publicly perform, publicly display, reformat, translate, excerpt (in whole or in part), distribute, and archive your User Content for any purpose in connection with Veristo. Mile Out has the right to use all data that does not personally identify and/or cannot be combined with readily available information to identify an individual User to Mile Out for its internal business purposes, including without limitation for research and marketing, product enhancement and statistical analysis. Mile Out has the right to access your location via your mobile device and provide such information to actual or potential Clients and other Users of Veristo.

However, such license of User Content to Mile Out shall not apply to any posted information or content related to requests, proposals, proposal selection, contracts, and invoicing, whatsoever. Similarly, other trademarks and logos used in connection with the Services may be the trademarks of their respective owners with no rights accruing to Mile Out in any manner.

Mile Out has the right, but not the obligation, to edit, modify, refuse to post, reject, eliminate or remove any information existing on or transmitted to Veristo that it, in its sole discretion, believes (1) is unacceptable or in violation of this Agreement, (2) may create liability for Mile Out or its Users, or (3) may cause Mile Out to be in breach of its agreements with third-party service providers, including its internet service providers. Mile Out may share the information in your account with any other User who has added you to their Organization on Veristo.

User Content Reliance Disclaimer

Mile Out expressly disclaims any liability for the accuracy of any such information, or the relevance of any such information in connection with Veristo. You acknowledge and agree that such information is self-reported by the relevant User, may vary significantly from time to time, and depending upon the provider of such information, may or may not be a reliable predictor of a User's abilities or performance and is done at your sole risk. By using services provided by such vendors on Veristo you hereby consent to the automatic, public release of your report's results. Mile Out expressly disclaims any and all liability for the release of such information in your User profile, or for any other User's reliance on such self-reported User information, and you expressly release Mile Out for any liability associated with such posting and reliance.

Legal Compliance

You will abide by all applicable laws, statutes, ordinances and regulations, including laws governing speech (e.g., defamation), copyright, personal privacy, confidentiality, and other individual rights in using Veristo. You may not post content on or communicate through the Veristo website in violation of any applicable law, nor require a User to violate any applicable law or agreement, including any confidentiality or non-disclosure agreement.

Fairness; Responsible Communications and Representations

Veristo is designed to be an interactive platform between Users. When using Veristo, you shall (1) conduct your business with the highest ethical standards and with fairness, and (2) treat and communicate with other Users in a respectful and professional manner. None of your communications

on or through Veristo shall be unlawful, defamatory, threatening or harassing. You will not disclose any information concerning other Users that is not already contained in the public domain, except to the extent permitted by such other Users.

Templates, Forms, and Other Tools

All templates, forms, and other tools provided on Veristo are made available for reference only and are not considered to be provided by any attorney or legal counsel. Thus, as provided for in this Agreement, we make no warranty regarding their suitability for use and hold no liability for your use of these templates, forms, and other tools, and, similarly, you will abide by the covenant not to sue and liability limitations set forth in this Agreement when using these templates, forms and other tools. We encourage and recommend that you review any and all potentially legally binding documents created in Veristo with competent legal counsel.

Taxes and Reporting

You are responsible for payment and reporting of any taxes related to your usage of Veristo. Mile Out is not obligated to determine the applicability of any taxes or to remit, collect or report any such applicable taxes. Users who are U.S. citizens or other U.S. persons (as defined in IRS Form W-9) may be required to provide a completed IRS Form W-9, to be updated annually, or upon any change in the User's tax status and/or change in the User's name or taxpayer identification number (TIN) to support certain Veristo capabilities. Other Users may be required to provide the data necessary to complete the necessary tax reporting forms, to be updated annually, or upon any change in the Users' tax status and are required to complete IRS Form W-8 to support certain Veristo capabilities.

Dispute Resolution

In the event of any dispute between you and Mile Out that cannot be resolved informally within 30 days after the dispute arises, the parties agree to mediation using The American Arbitration Association in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and if the parties cannot voluntarily reach agreement within 30 days after the commencement of the mediation, the parties shall consent to have the mediator decide the outcome of the dispute, which decision shall be final and binding on the parties. The Federal Arbitration Act, 9 U.S.C. §1 et seq. and the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") Employment Arbitration Rules and Mediation Procedures shall apply to the dispute. The laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall govern the interpretation of this Agreement and the substantive merits of any legal dispute arising from or related to this Agreement, without regard to conflicts of law provisions. THE PARTIES WAIVE ANY RIGHTS TO TRIAL BY JURY WITH RESPECT TO ANY DISPUTE. TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, YOU RELEASE MILE OUT, ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS AND AFFILIATES FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS AND DAMAGES OF EVERY KIND AND NATURE, KNOWN AND UNKNOWN, SUSPECTED AND UNSUSPECTED, DISCLOSED AND UNDISCLOSED, THAT ARE NOW IN EXISTENCE OR MAY ARISE IN THE FUTURE AND IN ANY WAY RELATE TO A DISPUTE WITH ONE OR MORE USERS, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION, A DISPUTE ARISING OUT OF THE USE OF VERISTO PAYMENTS DUE TO YOU FROM A CLIENT OR COMPLIANCE WITH THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT.

YOU AGREE THAT ANY CLAIMS SUBJECT TO MEDIATION HEREUNDER MUST BE MADE IN YOUR INDIVIDUAL CAPACITY, AND NOT AS A PLAINTIFF OR CLASS MEMBER IN ANY PURPORTED CLASS OR REPRESENTATIVE PROCEEDING.

To the extent permitted by law, with regard to any dispute between Users, including without limitation, disputes concerning, in whole or in part, claims related to work quality, the payment of fees and expenses, business harm or equipment damage, or compliance with the terms of this Agreement, the

Users will resolve the dispute between themselves without involving Mile Out in any way. If the Users cannot resolve the dispute informally, they shall proceed according to the dispute resolution procedures set forth above. All Users agree that they will not seek any form of support from Mile Out, including without limitation, subpoenas for documents or witness testimony.

Independent Contractor Status and Relationship of the Parties

All parties to this Agreement are independent contractors and not joint venturers, franchisors or franchisees, partners, employees, agents or brokers of Mile Out. Each User hereby acknowledges and agrees that Veristo is intended for use solely by Users who can appropriately enter into Work Engagements through independent contractor relationships in accordance with applicable law.

Communications

You agree and consent to receive electronically all communications, agreements, documents, notices and disclosures (collectively, "Communications") that Mile Out provides in connection with your Account and your use of Veristo. Communications include: agreements and policies you agreed to (e.g., this Agreement; updates to Mile Out agreements or policies; transaction receipts or confirmations; Account statements and history; federal and state tax statements Mile Out is required to make available to you; and any other information related to any other Account or your transactions on Veristo.) Mile Out will provide these Communications to you by posting them on the Mile Out website, emailing them to you via the email information provided in your Account, or transmitting them to you via the SMS information provided in your Account. In order to access and retain electronic Communications, you will need a current web browser (Mile Out supports the latest versions of all commonly used web browsers) with cookies enabled; a recent version of Adobe Acrobat Reader to open documents in .pdf format; a valid email address (your primary email address on file with Mile Out); and sufficient storage space to save past Communications or an installed printer to print them. Mile Out will notify you if there are any material changes to the hardware or software needed to receive electronic Communications from Mile Out by updating this Agreement. By giving your consent above, you are confirming that you have access to the necessary equipment and are able to receive, open, and print or download a copy of any Communications for your records. You may print or save a copy of these Communications for your records as they may not be accessible online at a later date. You may withdraw your consent to receive Communications electronically by writing to us by email at info@veristo.com. If you fail to provide or if you withdraw your consent to receive Communications electronically, Mile Out reserves the right to either deny your application for an Account, restrict or deactivate your Account, or charge you additional fees for paper copies. You understand and agree that if Mile Out sends you electronic Communications of any type but you do not receive it because your applicable email address on file is incorrect, out of date, blocked by your service provider, or you are otherwise unable to receive electronic Communications, Mile Out will be deemed to have provided the Communication to you. Please note that if you use a spam filter that blocks or re-routes emails from senders not listed in your email address book, you must add Mile Out to your email address book so that you will be able to receive the Communications Mile Out sends to you. You can update your primary email address or street address at any time by logging into the Veristo website. If your email address becomes invalid such that electronic Communications sent to you by Mile Out are returned, Mile Out may deem your Account to be inactive, and you will not be able to transact any activity using your Mile Out Account until Mile Out receives a valid, working applicable email address from you.

No Warranty

Mile Out does not make any representations and disclaims all warranties, expressed or implied, regarding the User Content, including with respect to accuracy, legality, safety, completeness or quality

thereof. Mile Out cannot and does not guarantee verification of each User's identity and/or the information contained in any User profile or the suitability of any User to fulfill its obligations made through Veristo. Consequently, it is your responsibility to verify the identity of any other User and that User's suitability for any engagements arranged on Veristo. Mile Out's Veristo website may contain links to websites operated by third parties: These links are for convenience only and Mile Out is not responsible for their content, privacy policies nor is the link an endorsement of any linked material. TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, VERISTO, ITS SERVICES, AND USER CONTENT ARE PROVIDED TO YOU AND OTHER USERS HEREUNDER "AS IS" WITHOUT ANY CONDITION OR WARRANTY WHATSOEVER. THE ENTIRE RISK ASSOCIATED WITH THE USE OF VERISTO AND SERVICE RESIDES WITH YOU AND OTHER USERS. MILE OUT HEREBY DISCLAIMS ALL OTHER CONDITIONS OR WARRANTIES, WHETHER EXPRESSED, IMPLIED OR STATUTORY, INCLUDING ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE AND NON-INFRINGEMENT.

Covenant Not to Sue & Limitation of Liability

You acknowledge and agree that Mile Out shall have no responsibility whatsoever for any actions or inactions of any User, including without limitation claims or disputes concerning the quality of a Worker's work, a Client's payment of fees and expenses, another User's compliance with the terms of this Agreement, or any form of harm to business or equipment caused by another User. You hereby covenant that you will not, anywhere in the world, initiate or cause to be initiated against Mile Out, any lawsuit, cause of action, claim, or demand, whether at law or equity, that is related in whole or in part to the actions or inactions of another User.

IN NO EVENT WILL MILE OUT BE LIABLE FOR LOSS OF PROFITS, LOSS OF USE, BUSINESS INTERRUPTION, LOSS OF DATA, COST OF COVER OR INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND IN CONNECTION WITH OR ARISING OUT OF THE FURNISHING, PERFORMANCE OR USE OF VERISTO OR SERVICES PROVIDED OR PERFORMED HEREUNDER, WHETHER ALLEGED AS A BREACH OF CONTRACT OR TORTIOUS CONDUCT, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE OR OTHERWISE. YOU AGREE THAT SHOULD THERE ARISE ANY LIABILITY ON THE PART OF MILE OUT, THAT MILE OUT'S LIABILITY SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE TOTAL SUM OF FEES ACTUALLY RECEIVED BY MILE OUT FOR THE ASSIGNMENT, AND ONLY THAT ASSIGNMENT, THAT CAUSED SUCH LIABILITY.

Indemnification

You agree that Mile Out shall not be responsible for, and you shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Mile Out, its officers, directors, employees, agents, representatives and corporate affiliates from, any claims, actions, demands, damages, liabilities, and costs (including attorney's fees) in any way arising out of or in connection with your or another User's (1) Content, (2) access or use of Veristo, (3) violation of any term of this Agreement, or (4) breach or violation of a right of any third party or of any law, statute, ordinance or regulation.

Force Majeure

In the event that Mile Out's delivery of its services (including the availability of Veristo) is delayed, prevented or otherwise made impracticable by reason of any acts of God, floods, earthquakes, or other natural catastrophes; national emergencies, strikes, lockouts or other labor difficulties; computer "hacking" attack or computer virus; major failures of the internet infrastructure; any law, order, regulation or other action of any governing authority; or any other cause beyond Mile Out's reasonable control, Mile Out shall be excused from such delivery to the extent that its delivery of its services is delayed, prevented, or otherwise made impracticable by such cause.

Voluntary Agreement

You affirm that you have carefully read this Agreement, understand the contents, have had an opportunity to fully discuss and review the terms and conditions with legal counsel or other advisors and freely and voluntarily agree to all of the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

Validity

If any provision of this Agreement is found by a court of competent jurisdiction or arbitrator to be illegal, void, or unenforceable, such provision will be modified so as to render it enforceable and effective to the maximum extent possible in order to effect the intention of the provision; and if a court or arbitrator finds the modified provision invalid, illegal, void or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions of this Agreement will not be affected in any way.

Interpretation

As used in this Agreement, the word “shall” and “will” are mandatory, the word “may” is permissive, the word “or” is not exclusive, the words “includes” and “including” are not limiting, and the singular includes the plural.

Entire Agreement

This Agreement contains the entire agreement between you and Mile Out with respect to its subject matter and supersedes all existing agreements and all other oral, written or other communication between them concerning its subject matter, and shall not be contradicted, explained or supplemented by any course of dealing or course of performance between Mile Out and you.

Notwithstanding the above and for the avoidance of doubt, any independent enterprise agreement or non-disclosure agreement entered into by you and Mile Out shall govern to the extent that there is a conflict between this Agreement and any independent enterprise agreement or non-disclosure agreement.

Termination

Mile Out or you may terminate this Agreement at any time with notice to the other. On termination, you lose the right to access or use the Services. The following shall survive termination:

- Our rights to use and disclose your feedback;

- Any other rights that Mile Out may continue to have under this Agreement.

Assignment

Mile Out has the right to transfer or assign this Agreement and the rights hereunder to any other person or entity without your consent.
